WHEREAS: The development of a person's abilities into skills for working effectively in the complex occupations of today is a joint responsibility of the individual worker, educators and trainers, and employers; and

WHEREAS: The schools of the State of Minnesota provide marvelous examples of linking education and work through guidance that recognizes career development as a lifelong process that is enhanced through the assistance of trained guidance professionals;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of November 4 through November 10, 1984, to be
