

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Public education is a community enterprise; and

WHEREAS: Education is a lifelong process; and

WHEREAS: Interagency cooperation promotes efficient use of limited resources; and

WHEREAS: Local residents have a right to be involved in deciding how the resources of their

communities will be used; and

WHEREAS:

Community education promotes the use of community resources and community volunteers in school and colleges; the use of public resources to provide educational opportunities for community residents of all ages; interagency cooperation to maximize the use of existing resources; and citizen involvement in educational decision-making; and

WHEREAS: The goal of community education is a sharing, educative community; and

WHEREAS:

'I Support Community Education' is the slogan of Community Education Day, co-sponsored by the National Community Education Association, the American Association of Community and Junior Colleges, and the Minnesota Community Education Association;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, November 13, 1984, to be

COMMUNITY EDUCATION DAY

in Minnesota and call upon the people of Minnesota to recognize and celebrate the bonds they have discovered, the partnerships they have formed, and the sense of community they have strengthened through community education programs.
