WHEREAS: Irv Williams is celebrating his fiftieth year as a jazz performing artist; and

WHEREAS: Today's concert in his honor is a demonstration of the high esteem in which Irv Williams is held by his peers and friends; and

WHEREAS: As a musician performing with such jazz greats as Sara Vaughn, Dizzy Gillespie, Oscar Peterson and others, Irv Williams has contributed greatly to the jazz community in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Irv Williams has helped to perpetuate the jazz traditions in this state through his dedication to, and love for, jazz;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, November 24, 1984, to be
