WHEREAS: There are more than 10,000 women veterans in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: These veterans contributed greatly to the armed services, and deserve recognition for these actions; and

WHEREAS: Women veterans have earned the respect and admiration of all of us; and

WHEREAS: They have helped to guarantee the continuation of the freedoms we know and enjoy; and

WHEREAS: In honor of their achievements, Congress has designated the week of November 11, 1984, as "National Women Veterans Recognition Week;"

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of November 11 through November 17, 1984, to be

in Minnesota.
