WHEREAS: UNICEF has an extraordinary record of service to children throughout the world; and

WHEREAS: National UNICEF day is a tradition begun in 1967 by President Lyndon Johnson, and continued by each succeeding administration; and

WHEREAS: Through UNICEF, the lives of millions of children have been improved, particularly in the developing nations; and

WHEREAS: The UNICEF motto, "Give a Child a Chance, Give a Child a Smile," is a most fitting one for this essential program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, October 31, 1984, to be

NATIONAL UNICEF DAY

in Minnesota.
