NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, December 5, 1984, to be



in Minnesota.


FURTHER, I encourage all citizens of our state to work to preserve and enhance human rights for all Minnesotans.
