WHEREAS: There are more than twelve million diabetics in the United States and the number of people developing diabetes is increasing rapidly; and

WHEREAS: Diabetes and its complications are the third leading cause of death by disease in our country; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Affillate of the American Diabetes Association is seeking to aid in finding a cure of preventive diabetes, as well as conducting research, educational, and community service programs here in Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of November 1984, to be

DIABETES MONTH

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to support the 1984 campaign of the American Diabetes Association, Minensota Affillate, through their contributions and volunteer services, in order to accelerate progress in the conquest of this nation's third largest killer disease.
