ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS  
TO THE CITY OF GOODRIDGE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF GOODRIDGE, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. WHEREAS, The sole owner of the following described premises situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Parcel 1:

Commencing at a point of beginning located on the West Edge or boundary of the present highway located on the East side of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty (20) in Township One Hundred Fifty-four (154) North, of Range Forty (40) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, in Pennington County, Minnesota, which said Point of Beginning is located Twenty-four (24) rods North of the Old Right-of-Way of the Minnesota Northwestern Electric Railway; thence from said point of beginning running South a distance of one hundred fifty feet (150') along the West Edge or Boundary of said highway; thence running directly West at right angles a distance of Thirteen (13) rods; thence again running directly North a distance of one hundred fifty feet (150') on a line parallel to the West Edge or Boundary of the said highway on the East; thence again running directly East at right angles a distance of Thirteen (13) rods to the point of beginning, containing 0.74 acres, more or less;

and

Parcel 2:

Commencing at a point where a line drawn perpendicular to the highway now existing and running along the East boundary of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty (20), Township One Hundred Fifty-four (154), Range Forty (40) would intersect said highway a distance of 24 rods North of the old railroad right-of-way, thence in a Westerly direction along said line a distance of 13 rods to a point which point shall be the point of beginning. Thence

in a Westerly direction along a line parallel to the South boundary of said Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty (20), a distance of 253'; thence at a right angle in a Southerly direction, parallel to the East boundary of said Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty (20) a distance of 150'; thence at a right angle in an Easterly direction parallel to the South boundary of said Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty (20) a distance of 253'; thence at a right angle in a Northerly direction to the point of beginning, containing 1.25 acres, more or less;

has petitioned to the City Council to have such land included within the City Limits of the City of Goodridge and has filed copies of said Petition with the Municipal Board of the State of Minnesota, with the Town Board of the Township of Goodridge of the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, and with the County Board of the County of Pennington, State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, The above-described property abuts upon the boundaries of the City of Goodridge, and

WHEREAS, No objections to the proposed annexation have been submitted,

NOW, THEREFORE, It is hereby determined that said land is urban in character and that the annexation of said premises will be to the best interests of the City of Goodridge and of the territory affected and the above-described premises are hereby declared annexed to the City of Goodridge.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and filing

with the Municipal Board, the Town Clerk of Goodridge Township, the Pennington County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and its approval by said Board.
