WHEREAS: It is every human's right to become a lifelong reader and to enhance intellectual growth and personal fulfillment; and




NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February 1985, to be

I Love to Read Month


in Minnesota, and that the attention of our citizens be directed toward fitting observance of this significant occasion.
