



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Kiwanis International, a community service organization with 310,000 members and 8,100 clubs, raised \$41.4 million in cash and donated more than 21 million man-hours to 80 nations and geographic areas; and

WHEREAS: The concept and principle Kiwanis represents is symbolized by the slogan, "We Build;" and

WHEREAS: On January 21, 1985, Kiwanians in Minnesota and elsewhere around the world will celebrate Kiwanis' 70th anniversary; and

WHEREAS: There are 5,400 Kiwanians in 118 clubs in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting that the members of this worthwhile organization be recognized for the outstanding service they provide communities in Minnesota and elsewhere around the world;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 20 through January 26, 1985, to be
