MINUTES OF SPECIAL ELECTION

M. , each of them duly took and subscribed an oath to faithfully discharge the duties required of them at such Election, and the said Judges and Clerk being duly qualified, forthwith opened the polls by proclamation, and the Election proceeded by ballot without adjournment or intermission until closed.

At 7 o'clock in the afternoon of said day the polls were closed, proclamation thereof having been made by one of the Judges thirty minutes previous thereto. 
