MINUTES OF SPECIAL ELECTION

At the Special Election of the Village of Gonvick, in the County of Clearwater and State of Minnesota, held at Querns Hall being the place where it was directed to be held by the Village Council, after giving due notice thereof as provided by law, on the 7th day of August, 1917, A. H. Helland, H. B. Bjerknes, and Martin Quern two qualified voters of said Village, to act as Judges of such Election, and one qualified voter of said Village to act as Clerk of such Election, each of whom had within twenty days before such time been designated and appointed by the Village Council to act as Judges and Clerk respectivly of such Election, A. H. Helland, H. B. Bjerknes & Martin Quern, who being present, at the hour of 10 o'clock A. M. , each of them duly took and subscribed an oath to faithfully discharge the duties required of them at such Election, and the said Judges and Clerk being duly qualified, for thwith opened the polls by proclamation, and the Election porceeded by ballot without adjournment or intermission until closed.

The subjects voted on at such Election, as stated in the Notice, thereof, were:

> To elect 1 President, 3 Trustees, 1 Recorder 1 Treasurer, 2 Justices of the Peace 2 Constables

At 7 o'clock in the afternoon of said day the polls were closed, proclamation thereof having been made by one of the Judges thirty minutes previous thereto. The Judges then proceeded to publicly count and canvass the votes, and a true statement thereof was duly proclaimed to the voter by the Clerk, who recorded the same in the Village Minute Book.
