- WHEREAS: The Health Occupations program of Minnesota provide its secondary students health career education; and
- WHEREAS: Students in Health Occupations programs gain health career information through classroom investigation; and
- WHEREAS: Students develop an understanding of current health care issues, environmental concerns, and survival needs of the community, the nation, and the world; and
- WHEREAS: Health Occupations education fosters greater understanding of the self and development of positive character traits; and
- WHEREAS: Participation in the student organization, Health Occupations Students of America, HOSA, prepares students for leadership roles in adult life; and
- WHEREAS: The 1985 HOSA theme is "Dreams of Today are Realities of Tomorrow"; and
- WHEREAS: The ever-expanding health industry has a constant demand for qualified workers with effective leadership abilities; and
- WHEREAS: These abilities are exemplified in the growth of Minne-HOSA; and
- WHEREAS: Minne-HOSA encourages students to strive for individual and group excellence; and
- WHEREAS: Minne-HOSA encourages involvement in local, state and national health care and education projects; and
- WHEREAS: Minne-HOSA encourages interest and concern for all people; and
- WHEREAS: Minne-HOSA members will attend and participate in the 7th State Leadership Conference on March 14, 15, and 16, 1985;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 10 through March 16, 1985 to be
