



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Congress has resolved and the President has proclaimed that the correctional officers who work in our jails and prisons and who are responsible for the containment and control of our inmates merit special recognition; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is justly proud of its correctional institutions and programs at both the state and local level and that correctional line staff are basic to the provision of humane services in an institutional environment and provide a basic public safety role; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is a national leader in the development and training of professional correctional officers who provide the day by day services that assure the success of correctional programs and facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 5 through May 11, 1985, to be

Minnesota Correctional Officers Week

in Minnesota.
