WHEREAS: April is Cancer Control Month throughout the United States by Presidential Proclamation and Congressional Resolution; and

WHEREAS: This annual observation and focus of community attention through the American Cancer
Society's Crusade is a critical part of the Cancer Control program to increase
knowledge and stimulate individual actions that help insure earlier diagnosis and
treatment and in an ever increasing number of situations even prevent cancer; and

WHEREAS: The American Cancer Society's annual fund raising activities have year after year
helped to support the medical and scientific programs that are now providing physicians
treating cancer patients with technologies that are saving more then 50% of those
developing cancer; and

WHEREAS: Scientific optimism about accelerated progress during the next decade poses the challenge for increased funding for itensified research in increasingly promising fields; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I. Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April 1985, to be

Cancer Control Month

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I urge every citizen to support the American Cancer Society's annual Cancer Crusade.
