WHEREAS: A wide range of minority enterprises are available to provide valuable business services to corporations; and

WHEREAS: The October 18 Corporate Minority Business Exchange will provide a means for minority firms to increase procurement opportunities with major Minnesota corporations; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is supportive of programs to expand minority business markets within the State;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, October 18, 1985, to be

Corporate Minority Business Exchange Day

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I urge all Minnesotans to observe this day with an increased awareness of cooperative efforts among minority firms and other Minnesota corporations.
