WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is concerned with the Education and training of students for productive, satisfying careers; and

WHEREAS: Members of the Distributive Education Clubs of America of this state are engaged in the essential tasks of providing goods and services to the consumers of our communities; and

WHEREAS: The members of the Distributive Education Clubs of America have chosen to pursue careers in the fields of Marketing, Distribution, Management and Sales; and

WHEREAS: The well-being of our citizens depends on the health of our economy; and

WHEREAS: The principle of freedom of enterprise is the basis of our economy and provides the chief impetus for its growth and stability;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 10 through February 16, 1985, to be

in Minnesota, and call upon the people of Minnesota to recognize and participate in this observance.
