NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February 1985, to be


Heart Month

in Minnesota.


FURTHER, I call upon citizens to support this important drive with their gifts and voluntary services.
