WHEREAS: The Minnesota Hospital Admitting Managers Association is participating in a national celebration honoring its members during the week of April 8, 1985; and

WHEREAS: The National Association of Hospital Admitting Managers (NAHAM) was formally organized on April 5, 1974, at Jamaica Hospital in New York City; and

WHEREAS: There are some 1,550 Hospital Admitting Managers in the nation, and they have contributed much to the improvement in procedures and the growth of service in U.S. hospitals; and

WHEREAS: The NAHAM has developed a successful accreditation program and highlights contributions of deserving admitting personnel and awards scholarships to Admitting personnel; and

WHEREAS: The admitting Department of each hospital is the first contact for each patient served; and

WHEREAS: The need for trained and professional personnel in the Admitting Department has become more important to every hospital because the role of hospital admitting personnel is increasingly more demanding; and
