WHEREAS: Improved productivity substantially reduces and often curtails the detrimental effects of inflation;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of January 1985, to be

Productivity Month


in Minnesota.
