Proclamation

WHEREAS:	The efforts of individual volunteers have contributed to the betterment of the educa-	
	tion, recreation, welfare, health, culture, economy and environment of our state; and

WHEREAS: Over half of all Minnesotans above the age of 18 (and almost an equal number of younger teens) work in some way to help others for no monetary pay; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has a long, continuous history of people voluntarily working together for community improvement which extends back to the ploneer spirit of pitching in to help neighbors in times of need; and

WHEREAS: Government, business and the voluntary sector are developing an increasing number of partnerships aimed at implementing new and creative solutions to problems ranging from meeting emergency food and shelter needs to an increased effectiveness in the use of citizens in the planning and delivery of other important services; and

WHEREAS: Voluntary giving of time and donations of money have an economic impact of over \$1 billion dollars each year in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The concern, commitment and generous gifts of time, energy and expertise by volunteers have made our state and our communities a better place in which to live; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is nationally recognized as a leader in the Innovative and investive development of effective volunteer programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 22 through Apirl 28, 1985, to be

Volunteer Recognition Week

in Minnesota, and urge all Minnesota citizens to express feelings of appreciation for those efforts and actions taken by Minnesota's many volunteers and volunteer programs.

FURTHER, I urge all Minnesotans to encourage the involvement of volunteers, wherever appropriate, in the programs of state agencies, local government, private nonprofit agencies and other private service organizations; and call on all Minensota citizens to join in the spirit of giving and teamwork by volunteering to renew and sustain the vitality of our communities and state.
