WHEREAS: The foundation of America's greatness is the strength of its families; and

WHEREAS: The family is established on the marriage relationship between father and mother; and

WHEREAS: There is an urgent need to reverse the present trend of separation and divorce that is sweeping the country; and

WHEREAS: Marriage should be viewed as a life-long commitment between husband and wife, filled with mutual respect and open communications; and

WHEREAS: It is our hope that the institution of marriage once again be recognized as the basis of American society;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, February 10, 1985, to be

World Marriage Day

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I call upon all citizens throughout Minnesota to support efforts to promote the permanence and stability of marriage.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-four, and of the State the one hundred twenty-seventh.
