WHEREAS: The American Association of University Women is the largest (193,000 members and 900 colleges and universities) and the oldest national organization for the advancement of women, education and lifelong learning; and

WHEREAS: The American Association of University Women has branches in 57 cities in Minnesota and a membership of 5,338; and

WHEREAS: Members of AAUW have been able to continue their intellectual growth, to further the advancement of women and to discharge their special responsibilities to society for over 100 years; and

WHEREAS: AAUW promotes equity for women, education and self-development over the life span, and positive societal change; and

WHEREAS: The American Association of University Women serves as a means for women to be effective participants in the arenas where crucial issues are being decided;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 3 through March 10, 1985, to be

American Association of University Women Week

in Minnesota.
