



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *Most of our forebearers were immigrants, coming from distant shores and countries; and*

WHEREAS: *In keeping with our heritage, we have recently welcomed many Asian refugees to Minnesota; in addition, the Minnesota-based American Refugee Committee (ARC) has continued to provide medical care to Cambodian refugees on the Thai/Cambodian border; and*

WHEREAS: *The ARC's medical supplies, facilities and hospital have been destroyed by shelling and attacks on the border, and now need to be rebuilt; and*

WHEREAS: *As Minnesotans, we will continue to support the efforts of the ARC and humanitarian aid to Cambodian and Asian refugees; and*

WHEREAS: *In proclaiming Cambodian Emergency Relief Week, we call attention to the Cambodian refugee situation;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 7, through January 11, 1985, to be

CAMBODIAN EMERGENCY RELIEF WEEK

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-five, and of the State the one hundred twenty-seventh.
