WHEREAS: Minnesota's technology intensive industry is a major force which will continue to improve the quality of Minnesota's economic and social environment; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's technology-based companies have provided a strong source of jobs and income for the state; and

WHEREAS: It is anticipated that there will be over 278,000 people employed in technology-intensive occupations in 1985; and

WHEREAS: There is a direct relationship between the quality of a state's educational system and the development and maintenance of technology enterprises; and


WHEREAS: Present technology-intensive industries, together with similar companies which emerge in the future, must be nurtured and cultivated if this record of accomplishment is to continue;


