WHEREAS: Philanthropy represents an American ideal; caring for the less fortunate through sharing of one's resources; and

WHEREAS: The Congress of the United States has encouraged citizens to give gifts, by granting favored tax treatment to benefactors; and

WHEREAS: The people of the State of Minnesota have consistently demonstrated outstanding leadership in the field of Philanthropy for its citizens and providing enrichment experiences for its people; and


WHEREAS: The fabric of our society is generally enhanced and made stronger when we improve the quality of our life, through such human qualities as: Education, Health, Arts, and Human Service;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, May 16, 1985, to be

Philanthropy Day

in Minnesota and do encourage the citizens of this state to contribute of their Time, Talent and Wealth to further develop and improve the qualified Charitable organizations of this state.
