ORDINANCE NUMBER 4.13

An ordinance annexing land into the City of Fosston

Section 1. RECITALS.

A. WHEREAS, the City of Fosston owns following described real property abutting said City:

---The Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the East Half of the Southeast Quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Thirty-three (33) Township One Hundred Forty-eight (148) North of Range Forty (40) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, containing 120 acres, more or less, according to the United States Government survey thereof, Polk County, Minnesota.---

B. WHEREAS, no part of said property is included in another boundary adjustment proceeding pending before the Minnesota Municipal Board, and no other municipality borders said property; and

C. WHEREAS, members of the Fosston City Council have determined that annexation of the above described real property is and will be in the best interests of the City of Fosston, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.

Section 2. THEREFORE, upon motion duly made, seconded and carried,

IT IS RESOLVED, that the aforescribed real property be, and is hereby, annexed to and incorporated within the City of Fosston, Minnesota.

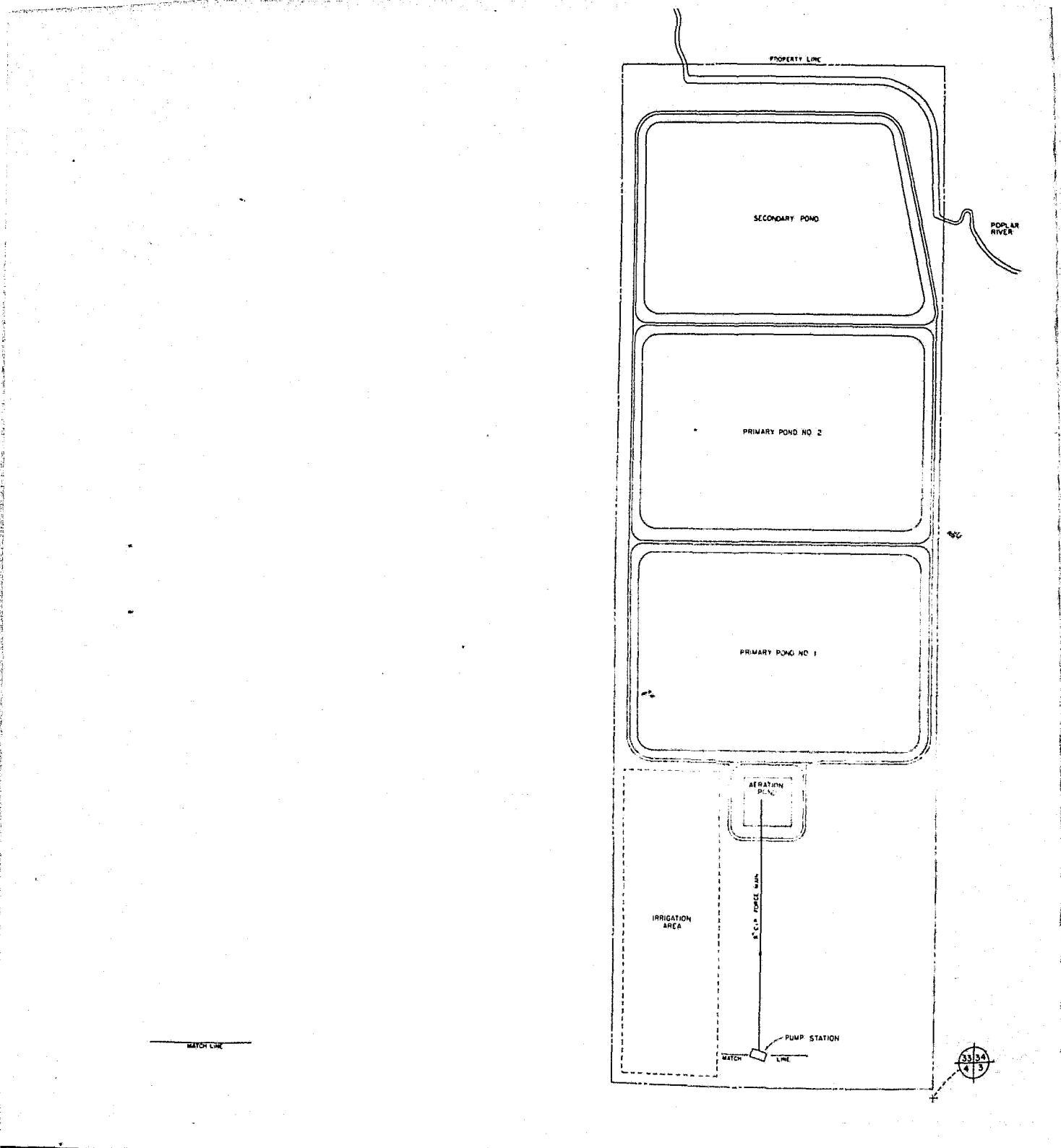

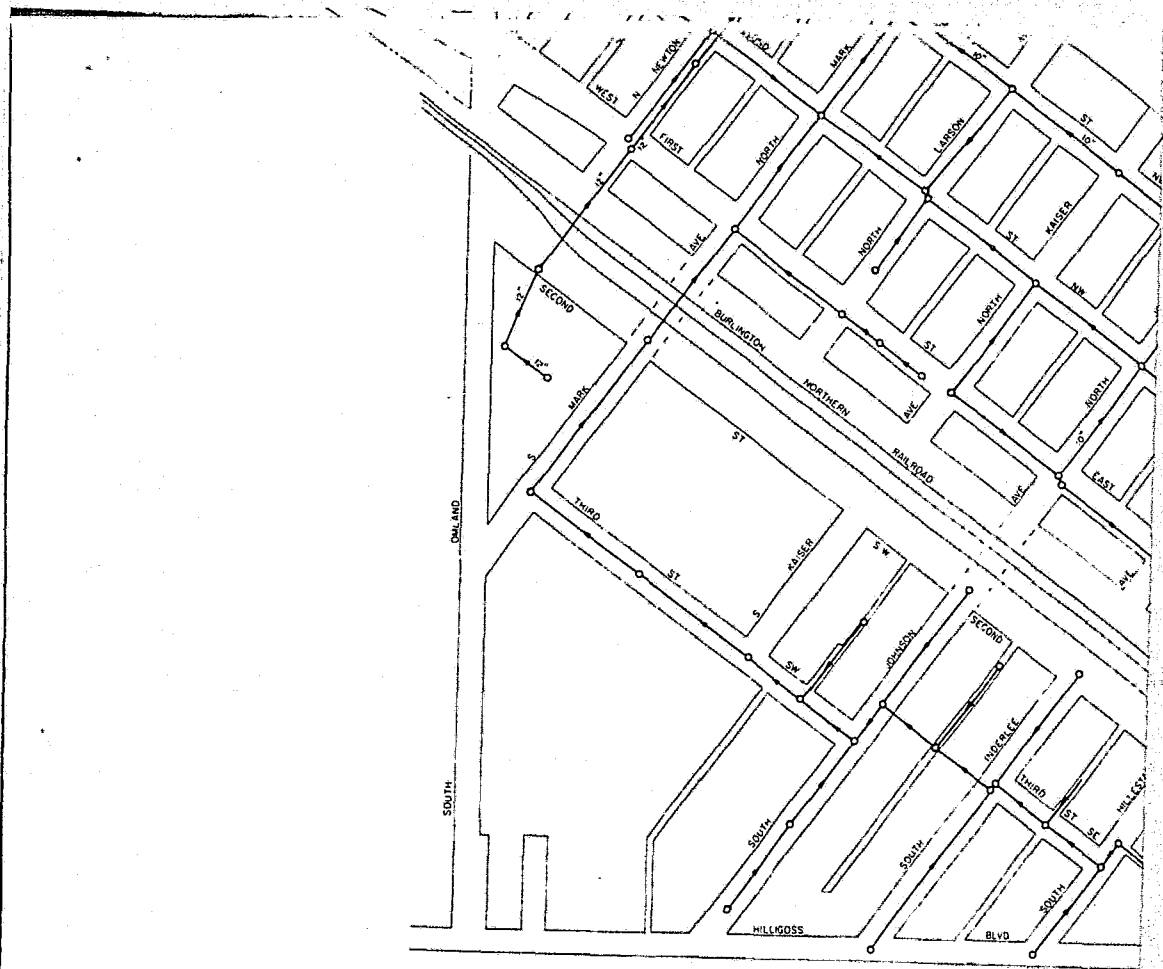

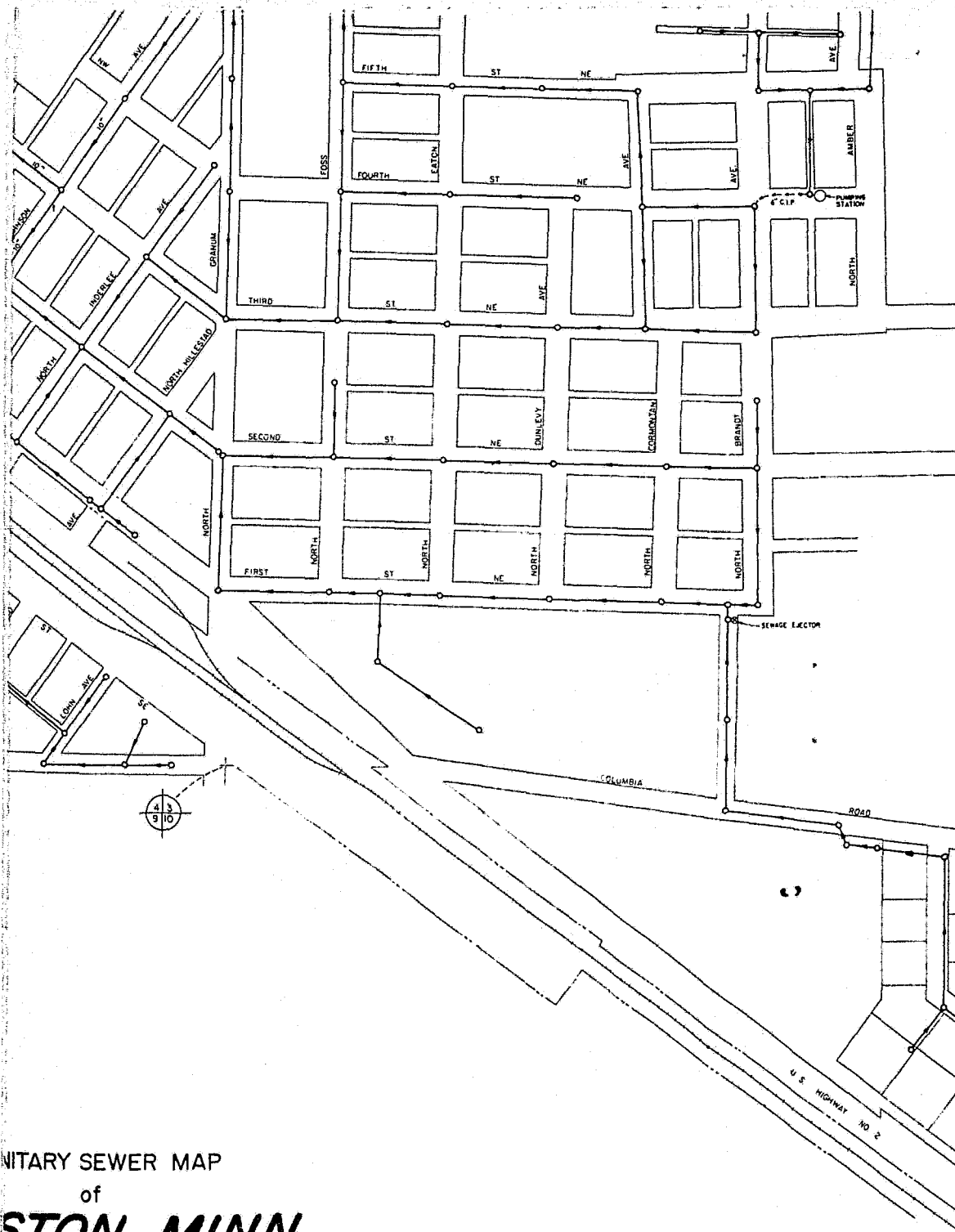

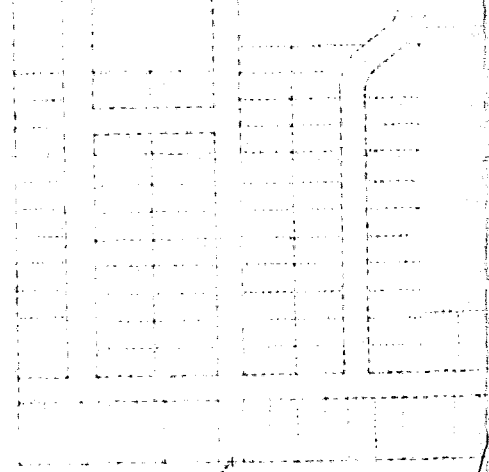
