An ordinance annexing land into the City of Fosston

Section 1. RECITALS.

A. WHEREAS, the City of Fosston owns following described real property abutting said City:

--- The Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE%NE%) and the East Half of the Southeast Section Thirty-three (E支SE支), Township One Hundred Forty-eight (148) North of Range Forty (40) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, containing 120 acres, more or less, according to the United States Government survey thereof, Polk County, Minnesota. ---
