WHEREAS: The citizens of the state of Minnesota benefit from the advantages of good vision; and

WHEREAS: Caring for eye health and good vision is an important responsibility of each citizen;

WHEREAS: Save Your Vision Week calls to attention the role of good vision in enjoyment of

lifestyles and productivity; and

WHEREAS: The observance is designed to heighten public awareness of the professional care which

is available for the preservation and protection of good vision;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 3 through March 9, 1985, to be

Save Your Vision Week

in Minnesota, and encourage all citizens of this state to take steps to protect their vision for a future of seeing well; and

FURTHER, I urge doctors of optometry, other health care professionals, the news media and community leaders to make efforts to educate the public about the importance of good vision and its care a priority.
