WHEREAS: The education of our children is one of the most important responsibilities undertaken by society; and

WHEREAS: Public and private schools provide learning opportunities in a variety of subject areas, building from the foundation of each child's reading and math skills; and

WHEREAS: Some children require special assistance to properly develop these critical reading and math abilities; and

WHEREAS: Chapter 1 of the Education Consolidation and Improvement Act (formerly Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act) provides public and private school children with additional instructional materials and personnel to assist those students performing below grade level in reading and math; and

WHEREAS: The effectiveness of Chapter 1 programs is enhanced by parental involvement and public understanding of Chapter 1 objectives and methods; and

WHEREAS: This is the 20th anniversary year of the passage of the original ESEA, Title I legislation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 3 through March 9, 1985, to be
