WHEREAS: The business leaders of Minnesota, and the greater Twin Cities, have gathered to demonstrate their support for the Institution Community Continuum Incorporated (I.C.C.I.) on Sunday night, March 3, 1985, at the Decathlon Athletic Club; and

WHEREAS: The Advertising Federation of Minnesota has chosen ICCI as the recipient of its 1985 Public Service Campaign, and has designated this evening to introduce its campaign to the area's business leaders; and

WHEREAS: ICCI is a non-profit organization working to provide a continuum of services for those in the state's human care institutions, beginning with selection and counseling, leading all the way to job placement and peer group support once they are released from correctional facilities; and

WHEREAS: The Advertising Federation of Minnesota and the leadership of ICCI have come together to ask that state's business leaders if they will give former inmates a second chance to re-enter society productively by offering job opportunities and support for this worthy effort;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, March 3, 1985, to be

in Minnesota for those people leaving our human care institutions; and I invite every Minnesota resident to join in saluting those of you gathered for this monumental dinner. We wish you success, and tremendous support, as you launch this public service campaign.
