



Proclamation

WHEREAS: We as citizens of Minnesota enjoy the freedoms conferred by our democratic form of government; and

WHEREAS: We demonstrate pride in our heritage by a high level of patriotism and support for our national laws; and

WHEREAS: We believe in strong military preparedness to safeguard our freedoms; and

WHEREAS: The Selective Service System has been directed to assist in the process of improving our readiness posture by calling upon eighteen year old male citizens to identify themselves by registering their name, address, date of birth, and social security number with that system at the Post Office within thirty days of their date of birth; and

WHEREAS: There is a severe penalty for failure to register;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April 1985, to be

REGISTRATION AWARENESS MONTH


in Minnesota, and on behalf of our citizens, I will strive to make eighteen year old men aware of the registration requirements contained in the Military Selective Service Act.
