WHEREAS: 1985 is the centennial year of the birth of Paul Howardanship, American sculptor and St. Paul native; and

WHEREAS: Paulanship enriched the lives of millions of people with his public sculpture, and his bequest of art works to Minnesota Museum of Art constitutes a valuable resource for the entire state of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota Museum of Art will open a major exhibition of Paulanship's work on May 18, 1985;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, May 18, 1985, to be


