WHEREAS: John Mariucci has served the University of Minnesota in an outstanding manner both as a participating athlete and as a Gopher hockey coach for 14 years; and

John as carried the pride of Minnesota to the National Hockey League as a player, at a time when American-born players were a rarity; and WHEREAS:

The flag of the United States of America has been represented by John Mariucci as coach of U.S. National and Olympic teams; and WHEREAS:

He is a member of the United States Hockey Hall of Fame located in his home town of Eveleth and serves on the selection committee of the NHL Hall of Fame in Toronto; and WHEREAS:

He has promoted the development of Minnesota youth hockey players through teams at the University of Minnesota and other colleges and universities; and WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: John Mariucci has affectionately become known as the Godfather of Minnesota hockey; and

The University of Minnesota has acted at pay him an enduring tribute by re-naming the hockey portion of Williams Arena as Mariucci Arena; WHEREAS:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, March 2, 1985, to be

in Minnesota.
