WHEREAS: This Grand Lady of Liberty has illuminated America's golden door of opportunity for millions of people hoping for a better life; and

WHEREAS: This symbol of America's independence and strength has experienced the ravages of time and the elements; and

WHEREAS: The American people, whose forebears gathered contributions to build the pedestal on which the Statue rests, are again joining together to restore and preserve their beloved monument; and

WHEREAS: America will observe the Statue of Liberty's 100th anniversary on October 28, 1986; and

WHEREAS: It is appropriate to recognize and celebrate the renewal of the Statue of Liberty, and it is equally important for the people of this nation of immigrants to reflect upon their ethnic heritage;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of July 20 through July 26, 1986, to be

Liberty Week


in Minnesota, and I urge all citizens to join in celebration of the vibrant heritage of this great state and this great nation.
