Thousands of Minnesota citizens are involved in the ownership, care, breeding, exhibiting and racing of horses in this state; and WHEREAS:

WHER EAS: The horse industry of Minnesota is a multi-million dollar enterprise; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota ranks 11th in the United States for horse population with approximately

236,000 horses; and

WHEREAS: 1985 will see the opening of Canterbury Downs -- Minnesota's first parimutuel race

track; and

The Minnesota Horse Council, a state-wide umbrella organization representing several thousand individual horsemen and women of varying interests, is celebrating its $50 \, \mathrm{th}$ WHEREAS:

anniversary in 1985; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Horse Council will be presenting its fourth annual Minnesota Horse

Exposition at the Minneapolis Auditorium on April 13-14, 1985;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 13 through April 20, 1985, to be
