

VILLAGE ORDINANCE NO. 90

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE VILLAGE OF BUHL

The Village Council of the village of Buhl, St. Louis County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That the five acre plat of land hereinafter described, and which is adjacent to and abuts upon the eastern boundary line of the present incorporated village of Buhl, St. Louis County, Minnesota be and the same is hereby annexed to such village and shall be and become a part of such village as effectually as if they had been originally a part thereof. Said land is more particularly described as follows:

Assuming the north line of the southwest quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-one (21), in Township Fifty-eight (58) North, of Range Nineteen (19) West, St. Louis County, State of Minnesota, to be due east and west, the bearing of the west line of the said Section twenty-one (21) is South, ten degrees, thirty-nine minutes and ten seconds west (S 10 deg. 39 min. 10 sec. W).

Beginning at a point one hundred eighty-nine and forty-five hundredths (189.45) feet south of the west sixteenth ($1/16$) corner of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of the said section Twenty-one (21) on the west line of said section Twenty-one (21); thence South eighty-two degrees and forty-five minutes east (S 82 deg. 45 min. E.) a distance of eight hundred twenty-six and twenty-six hundredths (826.26) feet; thence South seven degrees and fifteen minutes west (S. 7 deg. 15 min. W) a distance of two hundred and sixty (260) feet; thence North eighty-two degrees and forty-five minutes W. (N. 82 deg. 45 min. W) a distance of eight hundred forty-one and seventy-two hundredths (841.72) feet to a point on the west line of said section Twenty-one (21); thence North ten degrees, thirty-nine minutes and ten seconds east, (N 10 deg. 39 min. 10 sec. E) along the west line of the said Section Twenty-one (21), a distance of two hundred sixty and forty six hundredths (260.46) feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; containing five (5) acres, more or less, of which two-tenths (0.2) of an acre is occupied by Wanless street of the village of Buhl, leaving four and eight-tenths (4.8) acres exclusive of Wanless Street;

SECTION 2. This ordinance is in pursuance of the provisions of Section 1843 and 1844 General Statutes of Minnesota, 1923.

SECTION 3. The Village recorder shall file and record certified copies of this ordinance in the respective offices of the Register of Deeds and County Auditor, of the said St. Louis County, and in the office of the Secretary of State of Minnesota, as provided by law.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its due passage and publication.
