WHEREAS: I believe that every citizen should contribute to keeping his environment clean and healthful, should work together to preserve clean air, fresh water and the natural beauty of his surroundings; and

WHEREAS: Keep America Beautiful Week has organized millions of Americans for over a decade in a nationwide effort to improve the community environment by establishing recycling centers, restoring beachfronts, landscaping; and
