WHEREAS: Members of the Minneapolis/St. Paul community have expressed a sincere need for a public event to benefit the desperately needy famine stricken people of Africa, the Save the Children-Symphony for Africa was conceived; and

WHEREAS: Members of the Minnesota Orchestra and the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra and supporting members of the public and business community responded to this need by organizing and supporting this event with the local staff of Save the Children; and

WHEREAS: Save the Children is actively engaged in providing necessary medical assistance and food relief, and development in drought stricken regions of Africa, focusing on the critical needs of children and their families;
