



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Environment problems has jeopardized many species of bird and animal life, including the Eastern bluebird in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The efforts of dedicated volunteers and bird lovers, such as the Bluebird Recovery Program, have helped to bring back the bluebird population in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Non game Wildlife Fund, through the contributions of Minnesota taxpayer-contributors, has helped provide habitat, care and protection for many species including the Eastern bluebird; and

WHEREAS: It is appropriate for the State of Minnesota to recognize these efforts, and call attention to them;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 31 through April 6, 1985, to be

BLUEBIRD WEEK

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fifth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-five, and of the State the one hundred twenty-seventh.
