WHEREAS: David Roe has made life better for all working Minnesotans through his activities with

the Minnesota AFL-CIO; and

WHEREAS: He has spent his entire adult life in the labor movement, most recently as president of

the Minnesota AFL-CIO for 18 years; and

He has spoken for students as a member of the University of Minnesota Board of Regents; WHEREAS:

He has championed compensation for injured workers and income protection for workers who have been laid off and their families; and WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: He has worked for fair pay and fair benefits for public employees; and

WHEREAS: The minimum wage he championed establishes a pay base for all Minnesota workers; and

WHEREAS: He has promoted quality and equality for all people in health, education and housing;

WHEREAS: He is today spearheading planning of an national labor interpretive center, to be based

in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: That center will recognize the long and sometimes bitter struggles of organized labor,
