WHEREAS: The Minnesota Orchestra is recognized and appreciated by the citizens of Minnesota for its reputation as one of the nation's finest orchestras; and

WHEREAS: Music lovers throughout the land are served through the Minnesota Orchestra's many concerts, tours and broadcasts; and

WHEREAS: The Orchestra's award-winning conductor, Neville Marriner, has strived to attain an international reputation for the Minnesota Orchestra, through recordings and prestigious tours; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Orchestra will serve as our cultural ambassador to the great nation of Australia, as it embarks on a 14-day tour beginning May 13, 1985, the first American Orchestra to tour Australia since 1973;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, May 13, 1985, to be

MINNESOTA ORCHESTRA ASSOCIATION DAY

in Minnesota and urge all citizens of Minnesota to recognize the Minnesota Orchestra for its contributions to the quality of life in Minnesota and fostering international good-will through the art form of music.
