WHEREAS: May of 1986 marks the return of Halley's Comet and thus, by this celestial calander, marks the birth and death of one of America's greatest authors, Samuel L. Clemens, better known throughout the world as Mark Twain; and

WHEREAS: Mark Twain immortalized the beauty of the Mississippi River Valley Region which was and still is of vital importance to the development of our great state of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Mark Twain championed the cause of human rights through the power of his pen and was the first native author to present the essence of the American spirit to the world;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the summer of 1986 to be
