- WHEREAS: The high technology/embedded computer resources industry is deeply involved in furthering the development of the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: High technology/embedded computer resources companies contribute significantly to the economy of, and are a major employer for, the State of Minnesota and its citizens; and
- WHEREAS: High technology/embedded computer resources education is an area of major commitment for these companies and for schools, colleges and universities in the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The professional organizations, the Association of Computing Machinery and SIGAda promote the interests of the industry and the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The objectives of these organizations and the high technology/embedded computer resources industry will be achieved by the upcoming National SIGAda Conference; and
