WHEREAS: The University of Minnesota Band Alumni Society and the Friends of the University Bands Endowment will celebrate Dr. Frank Beniciscutto's twenty-five years of service to the University of Minnesota, in festival concerts and reunions on April 27 and 28, 1985; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Beniciscutto, as composer, arranger, conductor, author and educator, has promoted the talents of Minnesota's young people and has attracted talented students to the University of Minnesota from around the country; and

WHEREAS: Under this guidance and direction, University Bands have performed two Rose Bowl half-times, played at the White House and at many state and national conventions, performed in concert throughout the United States and abroad; and

WHEREAS: He led the first American concert band, the University Wind Ensemble, on tour through the People's Republic of China, and led a seven-week concert tour throughout the Soviet Union; and

WHEREAS: These efforts have spread joy and international good will for the University, the School of Music and the State of Minnesota;
