WHEREAS: The Orchestra has attained an international reputation through recordings and broadcasts; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Orchestra will serve as our cultural ambassador to the great nation of Australia, as it embarks on a 14-day tour beginning May 13;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, May 13, 1985, to be

MINNESOTA ORCHESTRA DAY

in Minnesota and urge all citizens of Minnesota to recognize the Minnesota Orchestra for its contributions to the quality of life in Minnesota and fostering international good-will through the art form of music.
