- WHEREAS: Children are the central focus of our families and deserve careful nurturing; and
- WHEREAS: To grow strong in body and mind, children need an environment of love and understanding as well as adequate food, health care and education; and
- WHEREAS: Our hopes for future generations depend on our efforts to provide the best possible world for the children of today; and
- WHEREAS: Those children who now exist in poverty and despair and suffer the deprivations of disease and malnutrition must be attended to so that they may have the opportunity to live full and satisfying lives; and
- WHEREAS: The children of Cornelia Elementary School, Edina, have worked long and hard to collect fund to further that goal; and
- WHEREAS: A release of balloons, each symbolizing a contribution collected by these children, is an expression of concern and hope from the children of Minnesota to the children of the world and a fitting opening to Save the Children Week;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 29 through May 5, 1985, to be
