WHEREAS: We, as people, have been endowed not only with the blessings and benefits of animals, but also with a firm responsibility to protect these creatures and to show kindness and mercy toward them; and

WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota are indebted to local animal anti-cruelty control and welfare agencies and to the Minnesota Humane Society for the invaluable contributions they make each year in educating us in humane principles, and in promoting a true working spirit of kindness and consideration for animals in the minds and hearts of all our people; and

WHEREAS: We recognize the timeless value of teaching kindness to our young people through humane education and realize that out of kindness toward animals grows kindness and love for all humanity; and

WHEREAS: The first full week of May has been set as the annual celebration of the national week observing the philosophy of kindness to animals;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 5 through May 11, 1985, to be
