- WHEREAS: The College of St. Catherine since its founding in 1905 has been a recognized institution in Minnesota for its singular dedication to high quality higher education for women; and
- WHEREAS: The College has been instrumental in promoting leadership for women throughout the State in academic, religious, political, professional, and volunteer roles; and
- WHEREAS: The College, through its devotion to the liberal arts, has provided the depth and breadth of higher education for its students in the acquisition of knowledge, in the appreciation of the culture, and in understanding of their heritage, as well as in the development of critical judgment and their personal commitment to intellectual inquiry; and
- WHEREAS: The College has opened its doors with cordiality to thousands of Minnesotans each year who attend concerts, lectures, art exhibits, and conferences on its campus; and
- WHEREAS: The College's sponsors, the Sister of St. Joseph of Carondelet, have an inherent commitment to the fostering of religious values which have contributed to the quality of life in the State through elementary and secondary schools, health-care facilities, shelters for the needy, and other institutions of assistance to the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The Presidents of the College of St. Catherine and the College's faculty and staff have served as eminent role models for women leaders throughout the State; and
- WHEREAS: Anita M. Pampusch has demonstrated her skills as an educator and leader by virtue of her academic and civic contributions locally, regionally and nationally; and
