WHEREAS: The peoples of Japan and the United States of America are seeking avenues of closer cooperation and understanding; and

WHEREAS: The Japanese Government and the Government of the United States of America, together with prefectural and state governments in both nations support such cooperation and endeavors; and

WHEREAS: A number of Japanese-American organizations concerned with economic and trade relations, academic and cultural exchange, sister-city affiliations, civic and service clubs, associations and joint businessmen's conferences will convene in Minnesota for further enhance their relations;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of July 1985, to be

in Minnesota, and ask all citizens to work together in promoting closer ties between our State and the people of Japan.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-five, and of the State the one hundred twenty-seventh.
